

Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer

Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer is a granular fertiliser that is designed to promote healthy grass growth in all lawn types.

Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer contains all of the macro-nutrients needed to support good grass growth, and also contains iron sulphate, which is widely used to control moss growth.

Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer has been formulated for use as a standalone fertiliser, and is conveniently packaged in 20 kg bags.

Benefits of Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer

- **Grows more grass:** Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer contains nitrogen, which is a growth multiplier. If conditions are right for grass growth, then applying Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer will boost that growth. Like any nitrogen-containing fertiliser, it should not be applied in winter, as plant growth is too slow to take advantage of the nutrients.
- **Replenishes soil nutrients:** When plants grow they remove nutrients from the soil. If lawns are mowed and the clippings are not mulched in, those nutrients are lost from the local environment, and need to be replaced to support the long-term health of the lawn. Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer supplies essential macro-nutrients that are required for lush grass growth.
- **Controls moss:** Poor soil fertility can favour the growth of moss, as can damp conditions and poor drainage. Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer addresses moss in two ways: first, by improving soil fertility, which supports the growth of desirable grass species; and second, by directly suppressing the growth of moss. The compound that achieves this is iron sulphate. Moss treated with iron sulphate will blacken and die, and should be raked out of the soil to minimise regrowth.
- **Promotes greening:** As well as controlling moss, iron sulphate promotes greening of lawn grasses, producing a lush appearance without encouraging excessive growth.

Using Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer

Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer may be used to improve soil fertility prior to establishing a new lawn, and also to maintain soil fertility in existing lawns.

New lawns: Apply Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer before sowing a new lawn. Spread the product evenly, rake it into the soil and water in well. Use a calibrated spreader to help deliver the correct rate.

- Apply at a rate of 200 g/m²

Existing lawns: Apply Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer every 6-8 weeks during the growing season. Spread the product evenly and water in well. For best results, apply after the lawn has been mowed. Use a calibrated spreader to help deliver the correct rate.

- Apply at a rate of 25 g/m²

Caution: Avoid letting Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer come in to contact with concrete or stone paths, as it may cause staining. If this does occur treatment with Diggers acid will be required. Do not use a bleach based product as this will lock in the stain making it permanent.

Storing Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer

Lawn Fertiliser with moss killer should be stored in a secure location and in cool, dry conditions.
